You need not complete all prerequisites before you apply, but the majority of credits (including 3 of the 5 science courses) should be completed before an admission decision can be made. All prerequisites must be completed before entering the program. Applicants should have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA and at least a 3.0 cumulative science GPA to be considered. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.
