BSA in action

The Japan Center at Jefferson was established in 2013 between Thomas Jefferson University, the Japanese Association for the Development of Community Medicine (JADECOM) and the Noguchi Medical Research Institute (NMRI). This collaboration is focused on coordinating the exchange of health personnel for clinical education and research between Jefferson and the other two entities.
