You need not complete all prerequisites before you apply, but the majority (including 3 of the 5 sciences) should be completed before an admission decision can be made. All prerequisites must be completed before you enter the program. A conferred bachelor's degree is required before the program begins (but may be in progress at the time of application). Bachelor's degree GPA and science GPA of at least 3.0 are strongly recommended but do not guarantee admission.

We will **not** accept coursework that is remedial or review in nature, Physical Education or Technical courses. Coursework may include Arts, Humanities, Social Science, Foreign Languages, Science, Business, Math, and History.
